This half term we have begun to prepare children for their transitions to school, we have been on school visits and have welcomed teachers into the setting. The children have



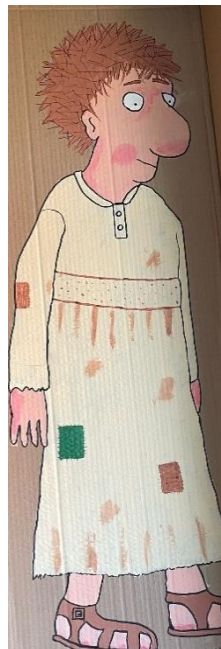
started to complete their school books each afternoon. We will be welcoming more teachers into the setting after half term and will be handing out a 'getting ready for school checklist' to all parents.
