Reminders for Chearsley & Haddenham CHUF Children

Please can we ask Parents and Carers to bring in a labelled water bottle at the beginning of each session in Chearsley, which will be kept in your child's tray.

The staff at both settings would also like to suggest where possible that bags that are brought into, or left in the setting are as small as possible as we are finding that some of the children's bags are covering the pegs of those either side of them, and in some cases there is just no room on the peg for all the child's belongings which leads to items being more easily displaced etc. A bag such a drawstring bag would be ideal if you have one available? We fully appreciate that bags can be expensive so therefore please do not go out and specifically purchase a new bag, but if you have an alternative to hand that you are able to use that would be great. Please note all bags and contents should be labelled.
