
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Term Dates:

Following on from the last newsletter when we were able to let you know that our Christmas Fundraising activities raised £436.41 (From the Christmas Raffle, Children's Christmas cards and mugs, as well as the refreshments on sale at the Christmas plays), we are delighted to let you know that have have purchased the following items using the fundraising monies. As ever, thank you so much for your continued support.

Chearsley have purchased: 2 Tuff Spot Stands for sensory and small world play, Coloured Gravel again for sensory play, 2 Wooden Threading Pineapples for helping to develop fine motor skills, and a Bumble Bee Colour Matching Game, also to develop fine motor skills. They are also hoping to purchase some Fairy Garden Toys in the very near future

Haddenham have purchased: Story CD's, Walkies Talkies, and new Clip Boards, which the children can use on listening walks, and they are in the process of purchasing, physical development equipment for the children to use both indoors and on the patio, to help with balance, stepping on and off and jumping.

Haddenham CHUF's Pre-Loved Book Sale

Haddenham CHUF ran a Pre-loved book sale prior to half term to raise monies for the Port Macquarie Koala Hospital. We are delighted to let you know that we raised £47.00 which has been sent to the hospital. The wildlife hospital has been using monies raised to purchase and install drinking stations for wildlife effected by the devastating bush fires, as well as a water carrying vehicle to replenish these drinking stations, they are also building a 'Koala Ark', which will provide a healthy habitat area for the wildlife to recover in before hopefully being released back into the wild. We would like to thank you all for supporting the sale. We have written to the wildlife hospital to let them know about the children's fundraising and we are eagerly awaiting a reply from Down Under.

Tax Free Childcare Scheme

This is a reminder that CHUF is registered to accept payments in from the Governments Tax-Free Childcare scheme that was set up in April 2017. This scheme enables eligible Parents to get up to £2,000.00 per child per year towards their childcare costs (The

Government will pay £2.00 for every £8.00 you pay your childcare provider. This is paid via an online childcare account that you will need to set up for your child.

Please note that we have been advised by the HMRC that although we are a duel setting provider that we are only required to be registered once under our original setting (Chearsley). Please therefore only use the details below and do not try to search for the Haddenham setting, as the Haddenham setting's details cannot be found on the list of Childcare Providers. Lunch Box Reminder

Please can we remind Parents that packed lunches should not contain any nuts or any items containing nuts (Such as Pesto etc) as we are a 'Nut Free Zone'. Please can we also ask that if you provide your child with grapes as part of their packed lunch that they are cut in half, as whole grapes can be a choking hazard. We will and of course always cut up any whole grapes in the children's lunches, but there is the odd occasion when the staff will not realise that a child's lunch contains grapes before they have started to eat them. Many thanks for your co-operation with this matter.

Lunch Bunch at Chearsley CHUF

As many of you will know at Chearsley CHUF we offer Lunch Bunch on Tuesday and Friday (12.10pm to 1.00pm) as these are days where there is no afternoon session in which the Lunch session is usually incorporated into. Lunch in Haddenham is part of the afternoon session as Haddenham is open for all 10 sessions per week. Lunch is offered either on an adhoc basis by ticking the appropriate column on the signing in sheet on the day for £5.00 per session (This is billed half termly in arrears), or pre-booked for either the Tuesday or Friday (Or both) for the entire term at the discounted rate of £4.00 per sessions (This is billed Termly in advance). Please note that the Lunch Bunch sessions are predominately offered for the older children aged 3 and 4, as it is useful preparation in getting ready for school. In exceptional circumstances we are able to accommodate younger children at Lunch Bunch but this is at the Chearsley Supervisors discretion and if you would like your child to attend either on an adhoc basis or more regularly then please speak to either Cheri or Karen (E) in the first instance. In all circumstances we advise that children new to CHUF should be allowed to settle into the sessions first before adding the additional Lunch Bunch session.

Working in Partnership with Local Schools

Both our settings have set up partnerships with schools in our local community. These partnerships mean we will meet regularly with the teaching staff to both share our practices

We aim to gain further knowledge of how phonics, maths, communication and language

(amongst other subjects) are taught in reception class. This will enable us to sequence our curriculum to progress the children's learning.

We will also tap into the topics and themes the schools have planned this will allow our children to gain progressive knowledge enhancing their skills all age appropriate. We will be making regular visits with groups of children all to be

Healthy Snack Donations at CHUF

As per previous newsletters at CHUF we aim to promote healthy eating as much as possible, and we like to reflect this in what we offer at snack times. We ask for donations to enable the children to try as many different types of healthy food as possible, and also by asking for donations we are able to keep our sessions fee's lower. We buy as much as we can but very much welcome donations of any of the following: Oat cakes, rice cakes, crackers, crumpets, breadsticks, cereals such as Cheerios, any fruit or veg, dips such as houmous, or anything else healthy that you can think of. Alternatively, there is a donation pot on the signing in tables in both settings for you to contribute a small amount of money towards snack if you are unable to bring in any items in but would still like to contribute to snack time. We would like to thank all our generous Parents and Carers who continue to support our snack policy, it's much appreciated.

Outdoor Clothing

During the winter months your child needs to bring in appropriate outdoor clothing to CHUF each day. We try to spend time outside each session, unless the weather is particularly adverse. Warm clothing should include items such as mittens, hats, scarves and wellies. Please can you make sure that all clothing and footwear is clearly labelled with your child's name. Can we also remind you that Lunch Boxes and Water Bottles should also be named. Many Thanks

CHUF has received grants from Aylesbury Vale District Council and Early Years in order to purchase a new Parent Noticeboard for each setting. Absence at CHUF

Please can we remind Parents and Carers to call your child's setting to let them know of any absences such as illness so that we can record the reason for your child's absence correctly on our registers. This information is required by Bucks County Council Early Years Funding team, who audit our registers regularly. If a child is recorded as absent and a specific reason is not recorded CHUF is at risk of having the funding for your child's sessions removed. We ask that you telephone on the day during session hours rather than email these absences as whilst our email address is monitored most days there are the odd occasions when it's not and therefore your child's absence my not be noted until after the day. All emails are also monitored in our Haddenham setting, which is where our Admin Office is based so Chearsley absences when recorded by email then need to be relayed to

the Chearsley setting. The settings can be contacted on: Chearsley 01844 201858, Haddenham 01844 299123.
